



GROUP SINGING COMPETITION

Rules & Regulations

1. This competition is only for BB Companies in Malaysia. All members of the team must be participants of the Pesta.
2. This contest shall consist of ONLY one category that is VOCAL GROUP SINGING
3. Each Team must consist of a minimum of five (5) members and maximum twenty (20) members. The members must be from Senior Section or Primer Section (ages 12-19 years as at 1st January 2010). One Officer or Warrant Officer is permitted to make up the number. All members of the group must be participants of the Pesta.
4. Each Team will present one (1) song, either in English, Chinese or Bahasa Malaysia. The song must not exceed five (5) minutes. A medley of songs is permitted within the time frame.
5. Extra points will be awarded for own composition provided a current member of the Company composes it. (Boy/Girl or officers)
6. Musical instruments are not allowed. **Each Group must bring their CD.**
7. The presentation must be choreographed.
8. Props and decorations are permissible but should be mobile and hand carried and should be removed from the stage when the team steps down. No extra members should be allowed for props and decorations.
9. Lights and sound coordination is permissible only if facilities are available.
10. **No BB T-Shirt**, no **BB Uniform** and no **BB logo** is permitted. Each team is required to produce own costume. The costume should be decently presented.
11. Each team will be judged on the following categories :
 - Vocal Quality
 - Choreography
 - Costume
 - Creativity & Originality
 - Stage Presence
 - Overall Impression
 - Original Composition (bonus 5 marks)

12. The song rendered must be a Christian song. The title and lyrics of the song must be submitted together during the submission of the pre-recorded CD.
13. Overall prizes will be awarded to the top five placing.
14. A panel of judges will be appointed by the Pesta Competitions Committee. The judges' decision will be final. No objections or complaints shall be entertained.
15. The Pesta Competitions Committee reserves the right to make any alterations when deemed necessary prior to the competition. In such a situation, an official notice will be issued to the competing teams.
16. Preliminary round is conducted through submission of pre-recorded CD or attachment files that come with music and singing by the team.
17. Only top 10 teams will be shortlisted to compete in the final during Pesta.
18. In the event any of the Top 10 teams are unable to compete during Pesta, they will be replaced by the next team in the ranking.
19. Participating teams need to submit the pre-recorded CD (3 copies) or attachment file to the organizing committee latest by **May 1 '2010**.
20. Submission received after May 1 will be rejected immediately. The team is considered disqualified.
21. The organiser is not liable for lost or damaged CD/attachment file that submitted to the organiser.
22. The team can have rehearsal according to time and venue that will be decided by Pesta 2010 organising committee. However, it is subjected to the availability of time and venue.
